When reporting a work order or emergency, please dial the Maintenance Department number (301) 724-2055, especially if it is after normal business hours or on holidays. If you call in and do not get a live person, your request could go unanswered for a long period of time. This number is answered 24 hours a day by either a staff member or the answering service. Also, please do your own reporting of items when it pertains to your apartment. Part of the work order request is granting maintenance access to the unit that has the issue. If you do not live in the apartment, you cannot grant us access.

Cintex Wireless Free Cell Phones

Did you know you can go to Queen City Drive, down from McDonalds by the Job Center (the back of the old Murphy's building) and get a free government phone if you qualify. Cintex has representatives there every day, Monday through Friday, from 9 am to 5 pm. You will need to take with you a photo id. You will also need to show them a food stamp card or a medical assistance card. If approved, you will leave with a free cell phone loaded with 1000 free minutes, 1 GB of internet service, and unlimited texting. Each month, 1000 free minutes, 1 GB of internet, and unlimited texting will be reloaded in your phone by Cintex. You can ask for Mandy, Justin, or Laura, they will be glad to help you.
