As you know, our agency offers bulk discarded furniture pick up (except TV's) every Monday. This is for our tenants to remove broken or unwanted bigger furnishings from their apartments. As a note of caution, to those tenants who remove furnishings from around the dumpsters and take those items into their apartments for their use, you could be taking in unwanted pests. It is possible that the furniture you are taking could have bed bugs, roaches, or other infestations. You could be contaminating your apartment, giving you more problems than it is worth. Please be aware of this when you see an item that you consider taking for your personal use.
