Tenants are not allowed to let anyone in the building. Have your family members stay at home and have them to call to check on you.

Partnership for Affordable Foods (PAF)

(A lot of food for a small price!)

Queen City Tower will be collecting for the PAF program on Friday, April 3, 2020, from 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m., and on Monday, April 6, 2020, from 2:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. in the community room. There is a \$7 donation in order to receive the food and it must be paid on the dates above. Distribution will be on Thursday, April 9, 2020, at scheduled appointment times. Residents who donate the \$7 must be in the community room at your appointment time on Thursday, April 9, 2020, to pick up the PAF order or the items will be forfeited.

(<u>Due to the Coronavirus, residents who sign up</u> for PAF will be given appointment times to pick up your order. You are asked to come at the time of your appointment, no sooner. This is to protect all the residents at Queen City Tower. Thank you for your cooperation.)

TEFAP - Free Government Foods
