Preventive Maintenance Inspections

Entry is **Mandatory** in order to do Inspections as well as repairs. With the warmer weather and longer days, please remember that Cumberland has an open container law, which means no open alcoholic beverages can be consumed outdoors, on our properties, or in the common areas of our buildings.

Complaints

HUD Inspections

HUD is changing the type of inspections that occur at our properties. Inspectors are now required to inspect and score tenant's personal property for hazards. Some of those items include: personal appliances, busted tv screen, fans missing covers, electrical cords that are taped together, broken mirrors, sharp edges, blocked windows, poor housekeeping, etc. Depending on the nature of what the inspector finds, tenants could be issued lease violations and/or a notice to vacate, especially if the apartment fails for poor housekeeping, over cluttering the apartment, pet violations, or other health and safety situations.

The change will go into effect mid-2023 for all CHG managed properties. You will be notified once an inspection is scheduled.

Medical Marijuana

Any form of Marijuana, including gummies, pills, etc., is not allowed on any Federally assisted property, as this is a Schedule 1 controlled substance and illegal under Federal Law. The use of Medical Marijuana is prohibited by Federal Law on all properties or in your unit.

If evidence is found that any form of use or possession of Medical Marijuana, on the property, violators will be issued a notice to vacate.

QCT Residents

Please do not sit on the retaining wall in the parking lot. There is a table and benches on the back side of the building for socializing with friends and neighbors.

QCT and JFK tenants - We are noticing more shopping carts being left in hallways, elevators, and in stairwells. If you use one, bring it back where you got it from. Otherwise, they will **ALL** be removed.

<u>Public Housing Assessment System (PHAS) Score</u> CHG was recently scored on our physical appearance, financial, management, and the Capital Fund Program. The CHG received a score of 91%, which means we are still a High Performer.
