Re: Five Year and Annual Plan, Public Review, Comment and Hearing

The Housing and Economic Recovery Act (HERA), Title VII, Small Public Housing Authorities Paperwork Reduction Act exempted qualified PHAs from the requirement to prepare and submit an annual plan. Qualified PHA's are defined as having a combined unit total of 550 or less public housing units and section 8 vouchers and is not designated troubled under the Public Housing Assessment System (PHAS) during the prior 12 months. Therefore, The Housing Authority of the City of Cumberland (HACC) is a qualified PHA.

The HACC, as a qualified PHA, is required to hold a public hearing regarding any changes to the goals, objectives, and policies of that agency and invite public comment regarding such changes. The HACC submitted its Five Year PHA Plan to HUD covering the period of 4/1/2025 – 3/31/2029. That plan was submitted to by HUD on August 8, 2025. The only changes are an update to the Admissions and Continued Occupancy Policy (ACOP).

The HACC also uses this public hearing to present the rolling Capital Fund 5-Year Action Plan HUD Form 50075.2 as submitted by HUD on 8/8/2025 which provides a statement of capital improvements needed, including the recently added 2029 funding year. A copy of that form is available in any staffed HACC office for viewing.
